

Bedford Stuyvesant's residential blocks are filled with rows of majestic brownstone homes that routinely list at a market value of \$500,000-\$1 million. These homes are located in the blocks immediately adjacent to the Fulton Street-Nostrand Avenue retail district.

Accessibility

Located within a ten minute walk of over 100,000 customers, the Fulton Street-Nostrand Avenue retail district is centrally located and has easy access to a wide customer base via public transit or by car. Metered parking is available on Fulton Street, and two underground garages in the district

provide secure pay parking. Three city bus lines travel down Fulton Street and the New York City Subway 8th Avenue-Fulton Street line provides easy access to the rest of the metropolitan region with express and local service at three stations.




Space Available for Lease Restoration Plaza - 1368 Fulton Street
